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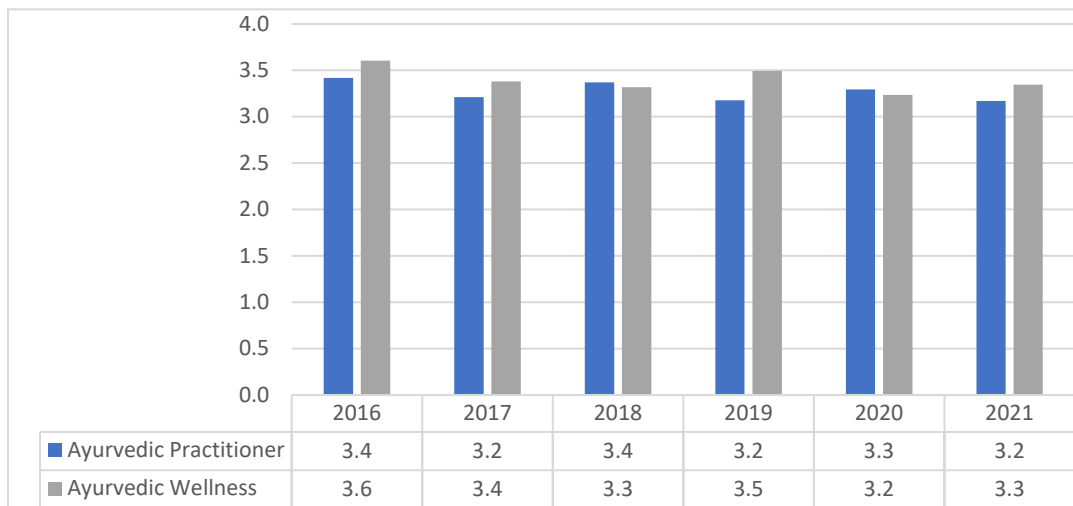
Average GPA at Graduation

The average GPA of the graduating classes of students from 2016 to 2021 at SCU is shown in the table below. With one exception, students in all programs have attained a GPA of 3.0 or above during this period. This demonstrates the excellence of our programs in imparting subject matter knowledge and skills to our students. Because grades are a composite measurement of student performance, they can be a good predictor of success. Grades are often evaluated by gatekeepers for many opportunities, including graduate school, internships, fellowships, and job applications.

The Doctor of Chiropractic program has shown a steady improvement during this period. Students in the Physician Assistant program have consistency achieved a GPA of 3.5 and above.

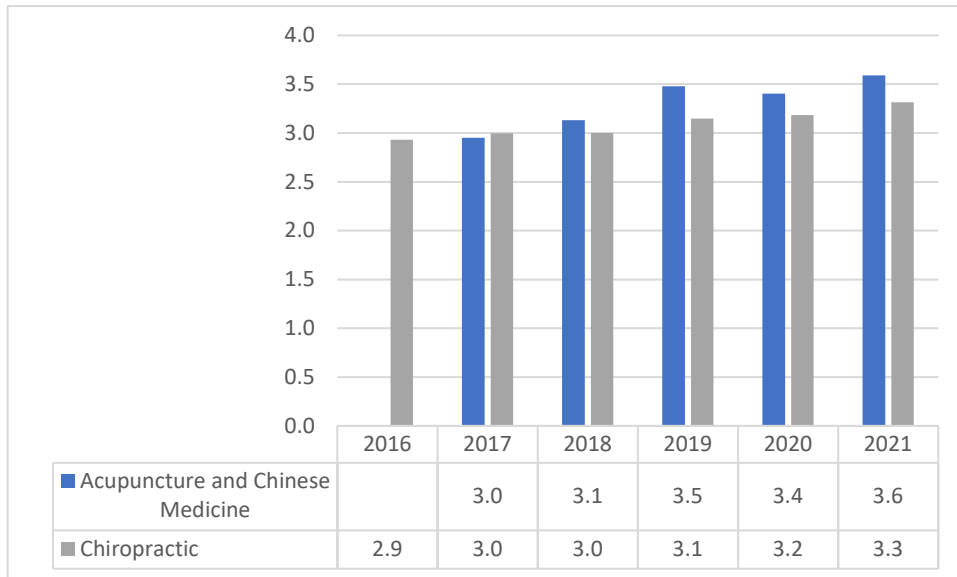
