

Campus Safety Reminder: Update Your Emergency Notification Profile

Good Morning SCU,

With the rapidly changing news concerning COVID-19 (Novel Coronavirus 2019) the Campus Safety Department would like to remind you to update your Emergency Notification Profile, known to SCU as “Everbridge.”

Everbridge is a powerful tool that allows the University to communicate with you quickly and effectively during urgent situations, especially during times when the email system may be jeopardized. While there is no current crisis concerning the spread of COVID-19 in our community, the situation is evolving rapidly and the ability to quickly communicate with our campus members is paramount.

Every campus community member currently has their scuhs.edu email address already registered by default; however, **it is highly recommended** to include additional methods of contact such as cell phone number for both calls and SMS text.

What to do:

- Login to MySCU
- Click “Personal Info” [top right of page]
- Click “Manage your emergency notification settings (Everbridge)”
- Click “Edit” to input additional contact methods
- Click “Save”

Important:

This reminder is being issued as a part of our continued efforts to improve our emergency preparedness, and not as a response to a threat or event.
