Dear SCU,

Considering the updated guidance from Los Angeles County, the State of California, and the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, effective immediately, the SCU campus will no longer require face masks in most outdoor spaces when 6 feet of distance can be maintained. If you feel more comfortable wearing a mask when outdoors, you may continue to do so.

In alignment with County guidance, we will continue to require masking indoors.

While this guidance applies regardless of vaccination status, unvaccinated people and those who are not yet fully vaccinated may want to consider wearing a face covering when outdoors.

All other SCU COVID-19 health protocols remain unchanged, including daily Smartabase Health Screenings for those working or learning on campus during a given trimester, temperature screenings and wristbands upon arrival to campus, and mandatory use of masks when indoors (unless working alone in a private office).
