Dear SCU,

The University was notified that a second individual on campus has tested positive for COVID-19. As an immediate response to protect the health and safety of our community, we are notifying all employees and all students.

With guidance from the Los Angeles County Department of Public Health, SCU conducted an assessment to determine employees, students, and/or patients who may have been in close contact with the individual. The close contacts were notified and are under self-quarantine. They will not return to campus until their quarantine period ends. **If you have not been notified that you were a close contact, you do not need to self-quarantine and you may continue your work and class schedule.** If you were not contacted, but are concerned that you were exposed, please alert us via the contact methods provided at the end of this email.

We have taken the following steps:

- Partnered with the local health department
- Potential close contacts at SCU were notified to self-quarantine
- Continuing sanitization of campus spaces
