Dear SCU Community,

With the Thanksgiving holiday approaching we want all members of the SCU community to be aware of the recent travel advisory issued by the California Department of Public Health (CDPH). The incidence of COVID-19 has been sharply increasing in many parts of the world, including in Southern California; therefore, the CDPH issued an [advisory](#) to self-quarantine for 14 days following travel.

To help protect those in the SCU community who are attending face-to-face labs, clinic, and work on campus, SCU is extending the 14-day self-quarantine advisory to include not only those who have traveled, but also anyone who has attended an indoor gathering with non-household members. This includes activities such as indoor visits with people you don't live with, even if they are family members.

Deans and Program Directors will continue to work with students who must quarantine so that they are able to make up any missed work and continue to progress towards graduation.
