Free Food Resources

The County of Los Angeles is offering the following resources for anyone experiencing food-insecurity.

- **Get help with food expenses.** CalFresh is a Nutrition Assistance Program that can help people in low-income households purchase food by increasing their food-buying power. Apply [here](#) and see eligibility requirements [here](#).
- **Find free food near you.** County agencies and partners that provide free groceries and meals are expanding their services during COVID-19. Click [here](#) to see options and find food distribution sites near you. Some programs also provide delivery.
- **Get food delivery assistance.** The County has launched a Critical Delivery Services program to deliver food and other vital items to adults age 60+ and individuals with disabilities who are unable to leave their homes due to COVID-19. Latest LA County Health Order

As a reminder, LA County Health Officials have extended the “Stay at Home” Order through May 15th.

The Department of Public Health reminds everyone that if you are ill, even with mild symptoms, please self-isolate at home for 7 days and until you are fever and symptom free for 72 hours. If you have been in close contact with a person who has tested positive for COVID-19 or is presumed to be infected with COVID-19, you must quarantine for 14 days from your last contact with that individual. Individuals who are elderly or who have underlying health conditions may be at higher risk of serious illness and should contact their doctor as soon as they are sick.
