SCU's Doctor of Occupational Therapy (OTD) program at the Phoenix Metro Campus offers students a cutting-edge, dynamic, and adaptable learning experience. This innovative hybrid program combines online coursework with immersive, hands-on labs, empowering students to earn their doctorate in just two years while preparing them for a career in occupational therapy.

WHY CHOOSE SCU'S OTD PROGRAM?

HYBRID ACCELERATED FORMAT

Earn your doctorate in just two years through a blended learning model that combines online coursework with immersive, hands-on training.

COMPREHENSIVE CURRICULUM

During this 2-year program, students can expect to take 107 credit hours over six consecutive terms, including summer sessions.

ON-CAMPUS IMMERSIONS

Attend the Phoenix Metro Campus twice per term for intensive clinical training that lasts 5 to 10 days.

FLEXIBLE LEARNING

Courses are offered in a variety of engaging formats, including on-ground sessions, self-paced online coursework, live interactive online classes, and immersive hands-on clinical training, providing a comprehensive and flexible learning experience.

WHAT IS OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY?

Occupational therapists work with individuals of all ages who experience physical, sensory, or cognitive challenges. OTs help patients develop, recover, or maintain daily living and work skills, promoting independence and quality of life.

- OTs can work in hospitals, schools, rehabilitation centers, outpatient clinics, and home health care.
